One of the best ways to get membership submitted in a timely manner is to start using MySAL. You've

all heard it before, but I cannot stress it's use enough. This might be the best tool that has been placed in our toolbox, and we need to use it. Visit [www.mysal.org](http://www.mysal.org) and get yourself registered. You will have your transmittal in a few short days, and you will have a more accurate picture of where your Squadron is on membership. You can print reports, find former members, and a host of other things. We need everyone to start using this tremendous system. **Who's next?**

Sign up for mySAL! The American Legion National Headquarters has designed a secure internet site to assist Squadron Adjutant's in their day-to-day membership processing duties. This site serves as a direct portal from the local squadron to National Headquarters' membership system. You must have internet access to use this tool.

Features include:

- View and edit member information.
- Membership Processing: Renew, Add and Transfer Paying Members
- Generate membership reports
- Submit Consolidated Squadron Report electronically
- View Squadron Information

Prior to creating a site, a Request Form must be on file at National Headquarters signed by **both** the Post Adjutant and the Squadron Adjutant. No other signatures will be accepted.



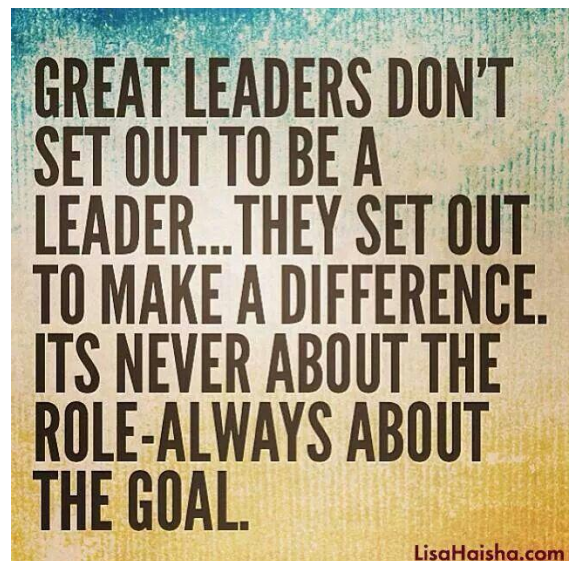
