Food and drink expenses will be reimbursed when a properly completed expense report (which will be supplied) and legitimate receipts are presented to the Detachment Adjutant for reimbursement no later than the 10th of the month following the conclusion of the campout up to, but not to exceed, the amount specified by the Detachment Finance Chairman. Hosting squadron will receive any fees for camper utility hookup. Participant fees for the campout will go to the Detachment. Additional fees cannot be charged for activities, unless approved, ahead of time, by the committee.

Food and drink expenses will be reimbursed when a properly completed expense report (which will be supplied) and legitimate receipts are presented to the Detachment Finance Chairman for reimbursement no later than the 10th of the month following the conclusion of the campout up to, but not to exceed, the amount specified by the Detachment Finance Chairman. A delay in submission of required paperwork, will delay reimbursement from Department HQ.

Hosting squadron should provide a proposed meal menu (similar to example). The actual meal served should closely match menu proposed. A final meal menu that varies substantially from the proposed menu is to be provided to the Campout Committee Chairman at least 2 weeks prior to the campout, to allow campout participants to plan accordingly due to personal food preferences or allergy considerations.
